### Moving and handling



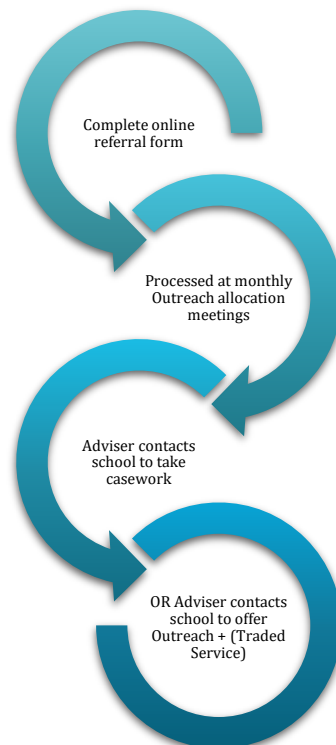
A chargeable service as

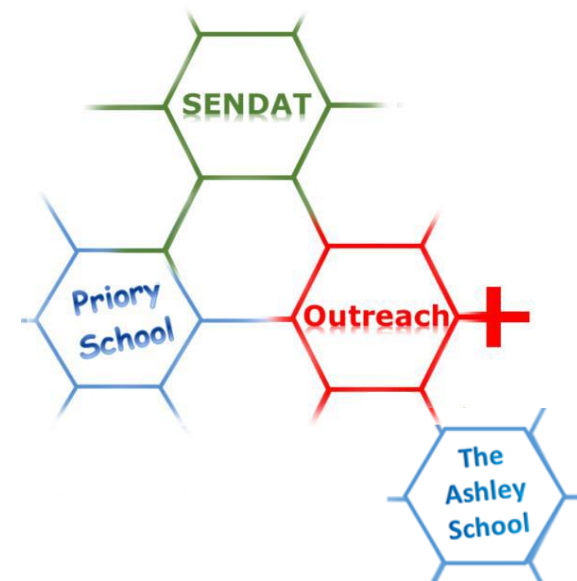

## Who is SENDAT?

The new Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Academy Trust (SENDAT) is a unique multi-academy trust focused on special schools and specialist provision. Led by two strong partners in The Priory School and West Suffolk College, it's aim is to provide a coherent approach to Special Education services.

As an Outstanding Special School and converter academy, Priory School will make their extensive experience available to ensure that our agenda of performance and quality outcomes for learners is applied to specialist provision.

Looking ahead, SENDAT's vision is to develop a continuum of specialist provision which enables it to fully support pupils with complex SEND whilst also engaging parents. This will remove some of the barriers that currently exist between different types of specialist provision making SENDAT symbiotic in its support structure.

We believe that high quality education is best achieved when the holistic needs of each individual pupil – social, emotional, spiritual and educational - are considered to be paramount. Through focusing on pupils as individuals, operating within a culture of trust and respect for all, we will tailor challenging and enjoyable educational programmes to directly meet pupils needs and truly personalise their learning. We plan to serve Suffolk with provision for pupils with additional Special Educational Needs and Disabilities within the SEND reforms.

The Outreach team are focused on Early Years, mainstream school settings & PRUs supporting pupils as follows:

- ❑ *Pupils who have significant and complex learning difficulties whose needs cannot be met from within the school or setting's local offer.*
- ❑ *Pupils whose significant and complex learning difficulties may compromise their placement in mainstream provision, making it difficult and sometimes challenging for the school or setting to maintain.*
- ❑ *Pupils with significant and complex learning difficulties who may have previously attended specialist provision and who require additional support, in order to successfully and/or maintain them in local mainstream provision Or successfully place them in provision in their home community.*
- ❑ *Pupils with significant and complex learning difficulties or physical difficulties who may also be Looked After Children [LAC] or in receipt of Pupil Premium funding.*
- ❑ *Pupils who have physical disability significant and complex communication difficulties that require an ICT assessment to enable access to the curriculum when their needs cannot be met from within the school or settings local offer.*
